

INSTALLATION OF R-290HD REAR MOUNTING KIT FOR USE WITH OEM TOW HITCH 2008-2016 FORD F-450 PICKUP

INSTALLATION SAFETY PRECAUTIONS

- Read and understand this manual completely before attempting installation of the equipment.
- Installation instructions provided below only address the RAFNA railgear equipment. Applicable railway company procedures and policies must be adhered to.
- Before performing any work under the vehicle or railgear, ensure the engine is turned off and the parking brake is set.
- Do not start the vehicle with the power steering hoses disconnected.
 Reconnect all hoses and secure the power steering cooler if the vehicle is started.
- Ensure all removed components are given to the vehicle owner after the installation of the railgear. These components must be re-installed if the railgear is removed from the vehicle.
- Always disconnect the vehicle's battery when welding on the vehicle or railgear to protect the vehicle's electrical system.
- Railway Company rules governing rail travel must be observed at all times.
- Never operate the vehicle if the Gross Vehicle Weight Rating (GVWR), Gross Axle Weight Rating Front or Rear (GAWR), or the wheel or tire load ratings are exceeded.

INSTALLATION OF REAR MOUNTING KIT

The following procedure details the installation of the rear mounting kit. The hardware required for this installation is listed in Table 1.

- 1. Remove the original spare tire and spare tire heat shield from under the vehicle's cargo box if so equipped. The original spare tire will not be re-installed.
- 2. Remove the tow hitch from the rear of the frame if so equipped.
- 3. Remove bolts securing the vapor canister to the vapor canister bracket which is located on the driver's side rear of the truck frame at the spare tire carrier.
- 4. Remove the vapor canister bracket from the truck by removing the two bolts securing the bracket to the truck frame and the two bolts securing the bracket to the spare tire carrier. <u>Use caution when removing the bracket</u>, the vapor canister could fall from the truck causing injury.
- 5. Remove the two bolts from the inside of the truck frame that secure the ground wires for the vapor canister solenoids. An alternate grounding point will need to be located for the solenoids at the installer's discretion.





Figure 1 (Vapor Canister Bracket)

- 6. Modify the vapor canister bracket by cutting the frame clip flush with the bracket as shown in **Figure 1**.



- 7. Re-install the vapor canister & bracket using the OEM fasteners. Only the rear ward most truck frame mounting point will be used when re-installing the bracket. There is a slot in the drivers side mounting bracket to clear the head of the bolt for the rear mounting bolt on the truck frame. Re-ground vapor canister solenoids.
- 8. Place each rear mounting bracket against the underside and outside of the frame rails as shown, just ahead of the rear spring hangers. The three slots in the side of each rear mounting plate should align with the three slots in the side of the frame. The two slots in the bottom of each rear mounting plate should align with the two slots in the lower flange of the frame for the OEM tow hitch.
- 9. Fasten each rear mounting bracket to the side of the frame as shown.

For Install with OEM Tow Hitch

- 1. Install the OEM tow hitch to the bottom of the rear mounting bracket using a shim and support bracket as shown.
- 2. Tighten but do not torque the fasteners.
- 3. Ensure the mounting brackets are tight to the underside and outside of the frame and are aligned with each other and that the support bracket is sitting flush against the rear mounting bracket.
- 4. Torque the 5/8" fasteners to 150 ft-lb dry and the 3/4" fasteners to 175 ft-lb dry. Do not over torque.
- 5. Weld the support bracket to the rear mounting bracket as shown.
- 6. The supplied railgear mounting shims are to be used as required when mounting the railgear to the rear mounting plates.


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
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

- Never operate the vehicle if the Gross Vehicle Weight Rating (GVWR), Gross Axle Weight Rating Front or Rear (GAWR), or the wheel or tire load ratings are exceeded.

OPERATION AND SERVICE OF REAR MOUNTING KIT

With the rear mounting kit installed on this vehicle, it may be operated as normal.

Never operate the vehicle if the Gross Vehicle Weight Rating (GVWR), Gross Axle Weight Rating Front or Rear (GAWR), or the wheel or tire load ratings are exceeded.

The rear mounting kit must be serviced regularly to avoid damage to the equipment. Table 1 below provides the Recommended Service Schedule and Table 2 provides Standard Fastener Torque Values.
